He repeatedly tried to change his father's mind but his father refused because it was a challenging task and it would be tough to purchase and install solar panels.









STORY: 2

She move near to the plastic pipe and saw a octopus inside it and thought if the octopus is stuck inside the pipe she went to help him get out from the pipe. After seeing clearly, there were many eggs inside the pipe. Every day with curiosity she used to see inside the pipe for larvae.

One sudden morning the pipe was broken and the octopus was nearby but the eggs were not present, it was very sad to know that due to sudden waves the eggs were wiped off by inside the beach and the mother octopus was left alone searching for the eggs. For an individual it is very unhappy time to face this situation.





Richa initiated activities to control the death of marine animals and make aware to the people nearby to make the city clean and green.

As there were many industries and factories there was a moderate water and air pollution in the city.

The locality people formed a community and by applying all individual ideas took an initiative to clean the beach by using empty boxes and thermocol, collected the trash and plastic so that the beach is clean and the fish doesn't get affected by it.

The people started using cycles and E-vehicles for shorter and longer distance travelling.

For the awareness and small contribution towards fight for climate change the people in the city started reusing the plastic and boxes for tree plantation and trash collection.







The houses in the city has water and seed feeders for the birds and animals. Senior citizens used to sit in the shade of trees and play with their grandchildren's and initiated a compost bin by collecting the leaves and the vegetable waste. The house roof tops were installed with solar Roof tops and green roofs.



They used solar electricity and during the rainy season they collected the water and conserve the water by harvesting it and percolation pit were built to save rain water which reduces urban heat effect. The sewage water through sprinkler irrigation was used for trees and the empty oil cans for plantation of trees.

The paper mills in the locality started using hemp to make papers instead of trees. Richa on the other step towards Environment started her own firm and named it **EcoRich** in which she made products like Tooth paste which were made from herbs but instead of using plastic tooth paste covers as they do not decompose easily made glass tooth paste containers and named it re-earth. Tap aerators were made to save 90% of household water wastage. The plastic wrappers were recycled by using charkha made hand bags and other useful items out of it. The plastic waste and wrappers were collected and cleaned to avoid generation of methane and inserted inside the plastic bottle and made Eco bricks from it. Further the Eco bricks were used to make shelter for stray dogs and used Polyurethane foam inside the shelter to keep it cool and were kept in garden for animals. They started Seed bank initiative and collected the seeds of fruits and flowers from wherever possible and made seed balls by using black soil, compost and water. Plastic use was avoided instead used glass material, use of Renewable energy sources and restoration of coral reefs was started. In this way Richa and the community people in the city invested for the city to make it clean and green.

Moral of the story- "WELL BEGUN IS HALF DONE".








If I can, we can and you can!!!!
